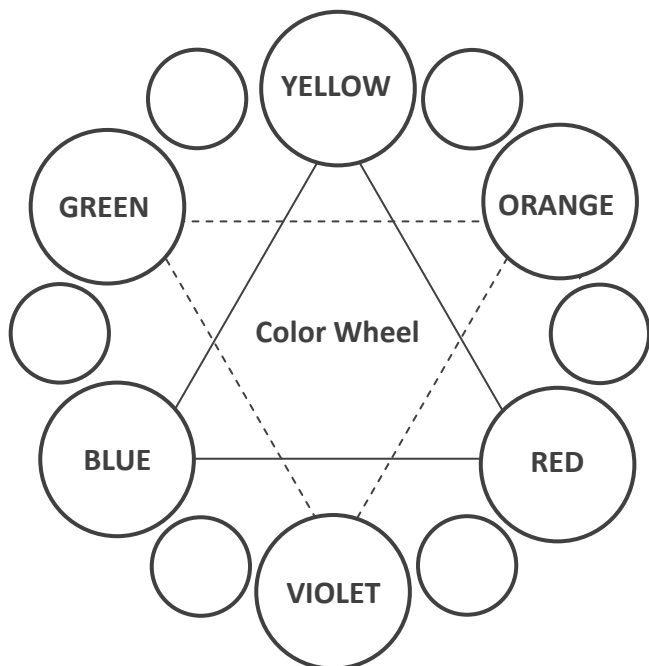

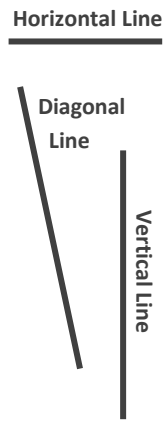

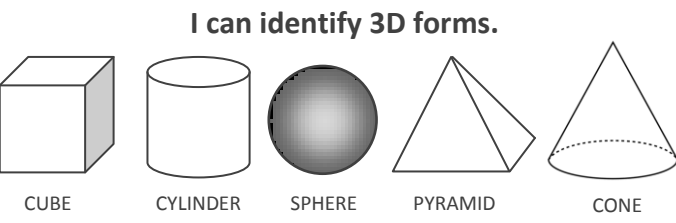
I can discover the intermediate colors and use them when I create art.

Primary colors: Red, Yellow, Blue
Secondary colors: Orange, Green, Violet
Intermediate colors: Red-orange, Red-violet, Blue-green, Blue-violet, Yellow-green, Yellow-orange
Neutral colors: Black, White, Gray, Brown

If I add **WHITE** to a color, it will become lighter. This is called a **tint**.
 If I add **BLACK** to a color, it will become darker. This is called a **shade**.
