


What Will I Learn in Second & Third Grade Art?

Primary colors: Red, Yellow, Blue

Secondary colors: Orange, Green, Violet

Intermediate colors: Red-orange, Red-violet, Blue-

green, Blue-violet, Yellow-green,

Yellow-orange

Neutral colors: Black, White, Gray, Brown


If I add **WHITE** to a color, it will become lighter.

This is called a tint.

If I add **BLACK** to a color, it will become darker.

This is called a shade.

I can identify 3D forms.

RED ORANGE YELLOW



COOL COLORS: BLUE GREEN VIOLET




