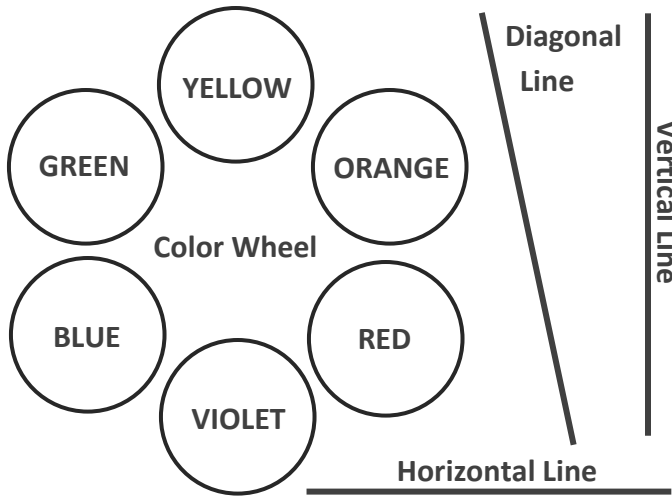

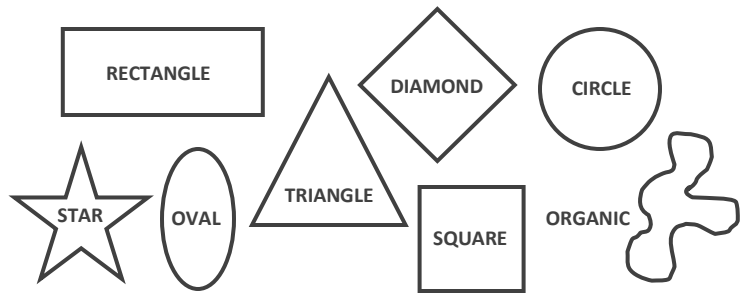
I can discover the primary and secondary colors and use them when I create art.

Primary colors: Red, Yellow, Blue
Secondary colors: Orange, Green, Violet
Neutral colors: Black, White, Gray, Brown

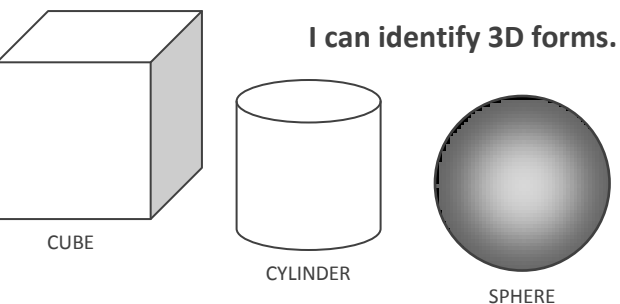
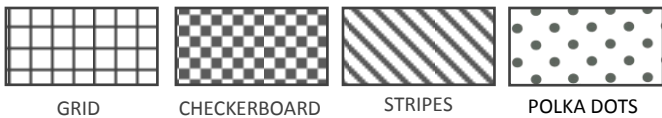
Red + Yellow= Orange
Yellow + Blue= Green
Red + Blue= Violet

If I add **WHITE** to a color, it will become lighter.
If I add **BLACK** to a color, it will become darker.

I can discover geometric and organic shapes and use them when I create art.



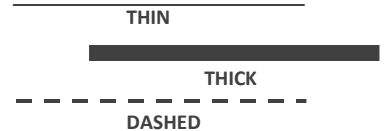
I can recognize types of pattern and create pattern in my artwork.
